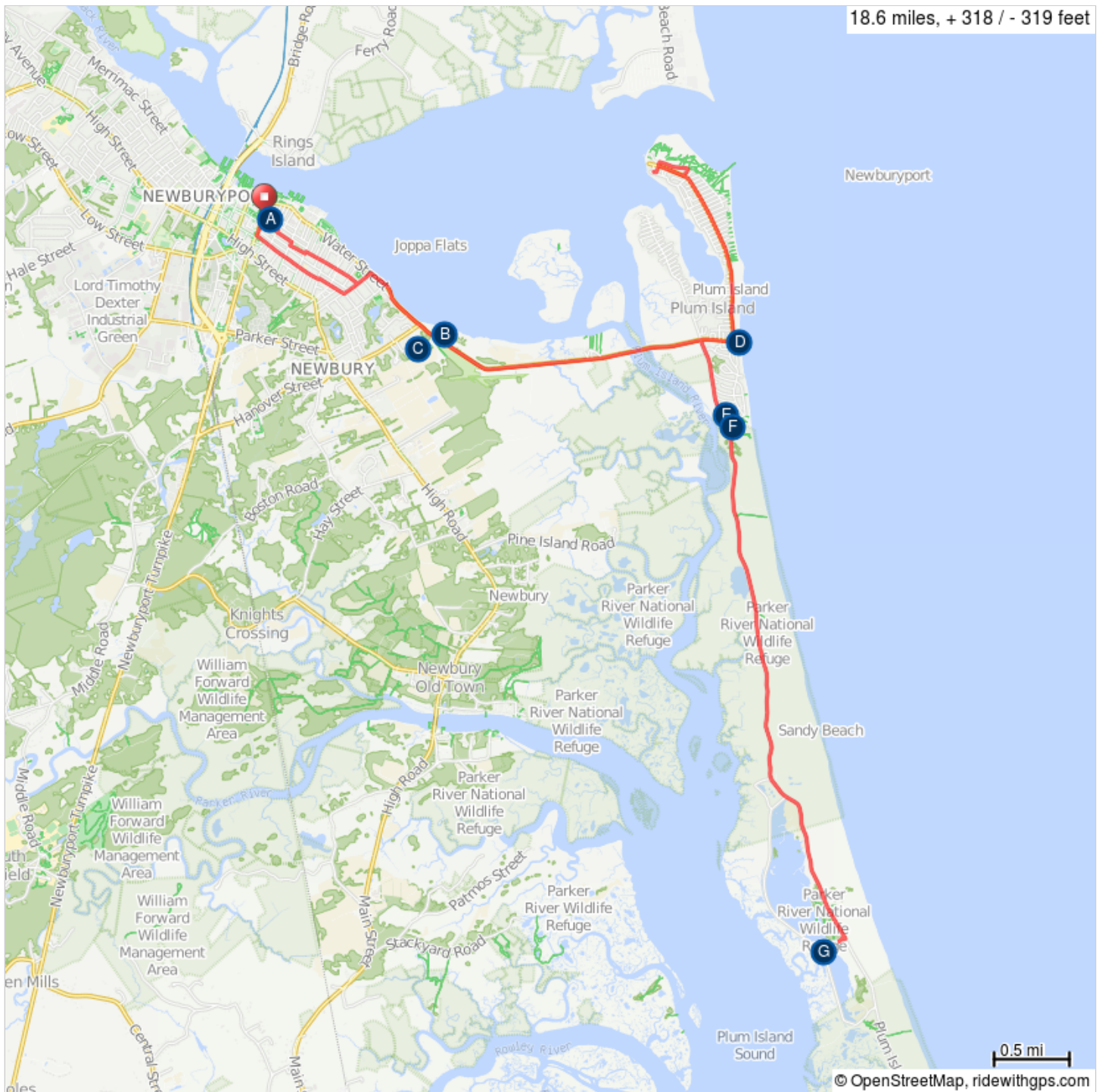

0.0	🚩	Start of route
0.0	←	L onto State St
0.1	←	L onto Prospect St
0.6	←	L onto Bromfield St
0.6	→	R onto Chestnut St
0.8	←	L onto Marlboro St
1.1	→	R onto Water St
1.6	↑	Continue onto Plum Island Turnpike
3.5	→	R onto Sunset Dr
4.0	↑	Continue onto Island Rd/Plum Island Turnpike
4.1	↑	Continue onto Refuge Rd

4.1 miles. +78/-91 feet

7.6	→	R into Hellcat parking lot at the end of the paved section. A walking trail takes you to a observatory tower.
7.7	←	L onto Refuge Rd, reversing course
11.3	↑	Continue back through the Refuge entrance gate toward the bridge
11.9	→	R onto Plum Island Turnpike
12.1	←	L onto Northern Blvd
13.5	←	Visit the lighthouse at 79th St
13.6	↑	Continue onto 79th St
13.6	→	R onto N Reservation Terrace

9.5 miles. +90/-88 feet

13.8	↑	Bear R onto 77th St
13.9	←	L onto Northern Blvd
15.0	→	R onto Plum Island Turnpike
17.1	↑	Continue onto Water St
17.7	←	L onto Marlboro St
17.8	→	R onto Purchase St
18.2	←	L onto Lime St
18.2	→	R onto Atwood St
18.3	→	R onto Federal St
18.4	←	L onto Spring St
18.5	→	R onto Fair St
18.5	←	L onto Essex St. Inn is ahead on your R
18.6	🚩	End of route
